Venezuela, together with Cuba, is restoring vision to thousands with free eye surgery. Cuban doctors are providing free health services to Venezuelans and training even more doctors. In **a year's** time 1.2 million adults learned to read and write—most in the rural Indigenous, urban poor, and Afro-Venezuelan communities that were ignored and underserved by the past ruling elites.

When corporations or owners close factories, workers have the right to take them over and run them. No government aid to businesses unless the workers can vote and decide the direction of the production. Jobs are a right!
